### Principal's Message

#### New Logo and Proposed Uniform change

I wrote to all families earlier this week around the proposed changes to the school logo and uniform. Students in years 3-6 currently have the opportunity to design a new logo and we have talked through this as a group. Entries are due to me by Friday 13<sup>th</sup> September.

Each morning from Wednesday to Friday this week the staff have displayed the proposed new school uniform that has been designed in consultation with the P&C and uniform supplier. Following this period of consultation we will make a decision about the proposed change and communicate this to our school community. If a decision is made to support the change all families will be required to complete an order form. The school will support this transition to a new uniform by providing every student with a brand new polo shirt and jacket in time to start the 2020 school year. Families will only be required to purchase the new shorts and/or track pants.

#### Indigenous Shirts

In Term 2 families were offered the opportunity to reorder an Indigenous shirt. Despite repeated attempts to contact the supplier we have been unsuccessful. It appears the company may have gone out of business. Those families that ordered a shirt and made payment will need to come to the school office to obtain a refund. I apologise for the inconvenience caused by this, unfortunately this is out of our control.

Miller Public School celebrated all of our amazing dads, father figures and grandfathers in our Father's Day Breakfast on Friday 30th August 2019.


